

Mid Kent Fraud and Compliance Team

- Mid Kent is a partnership between Maidstone, Swale and Tunbridge Wells Borough Councils
- New team set up in 2016 when Housing Benefit Fraud moved to the DWP
- 5 team members investigating CTRS, Council Tax discounts and exemptions and NNDR reliefs claimed incorrectly.

Mid Kent Fraud and Compliance Team

- Review carried out of all SBRR awards in Mid Kent
- Time consuming
- Caused confusion
- Large increase in phone calls
- Large amount of rate payers did not respond.

SBRR Review Results

Maidstone Borough Council	Swale Borough Council	Tunbridge Wells Borough Council
£350,870	£413,947	£294,066

- Not true results, many occupiers did not respond to the review
- Dentist with another practice recharge of £12,740
- Retail with another property in Bromley cancelled back to 2010 - £16,415

Kent

- Kent is made up of the county council, 12 districts and one unitary authority.
- The Gateway to Europe
- Close to London
- Some of the richest wards but also wards with high levels of deprivation

Kent Intelligence Network

- Set up to use intelligence across Kent to investigate fraud and error.
- Share good practice
- Network with other areas
- Data sharing agreement put in place
- Data matches carried out against SPDs, Housing waiting lists and SBRR.

KIN SBRR Review

- Data provided from all 13 authorities
- Looked to match, business names, addresses, phone numbers and bank account details
- Not all authorities could provide the same level of data
- Matches were poor

KIN SBRR Review Results

 Dog groomers one in Swale, one in Maidstone. Swale recharge - £5,428 Maidstone recharge - £14,235

SBRR Review using the HUB

- Kent authorities approached through KIN to start using the Destin Solutions Hub
- Agreed with the county to jointly purchase access to the Hub
- Data is obtained without the need to contact the authorities
- All KIN partners have access to the Hub




